Boothwyn Elementary School incorporates PDE's **Positive Behavior Support Program** to help our students become Responsible, Respectful and Caring. To help our students learn these important behaviors, we provide the following supports:

Teaching Expectations

Students are taught universal behaviors for the halls, bathrooms, cafeteria, and playground. Teachers set individual rules for their classrooms that also follow these guidelines.

Rewarding Behavior

We reward and recognize our students who display positive behavior in several ways:

- **Tickets:** Students can earn tickets throughout the day. Tickets are put into a classroom lottery and rewards are given every Friday afternoon.
- **200 Club Eagle Notes:** 10 students a day are recognized with an Eagle Note. Students who receive an Eagle note have an opportunity to win a prize, they get to sign the "Wall of Fame", and parents/guardians will receive a phone call home from the school so they know what a great job their child is doing.
- **Eagle Awards:** Once a month, 4 students in each classroom are chosen by their teacher to receive the Eagle Award at an Awards Assembly. These students wear a lanyard for the month and are our role models for the school.
