

HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE

All bona fide students of the Chichester School District are insured through the Bollinger Insurance Company of Short Hills, New Jersey. The policy is intended to provide supplemental health insurance when accidental bodily injury is sustained by a student while participating in a school-sponsored activity. The school insurance is a supplemental policy designed to assist families by reimbursing them for out of pocket expenses only after claims have been processed by the family's primary health insurance.

In order for coverage to be in effect, it shall be the responsibility of the student to report any injury to the Athletic Trainer within 30 days of the date of the injury.

Claims must first be filed with the family's private health insurance carrier. After settlement of that claim, you may file a claim with the District's carrier, which will reimburse a family for a portion of the unpaid balance. Information and forms regarding claims can be obtained from the Athletic Training Office.
